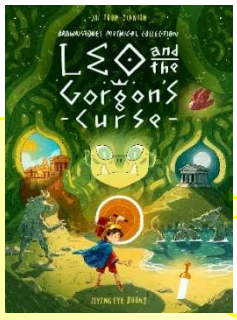
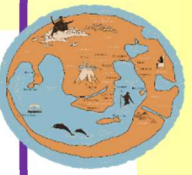
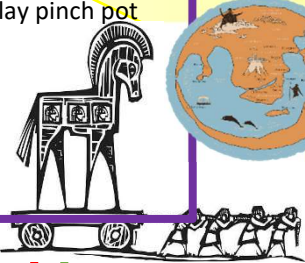
MUSIC
