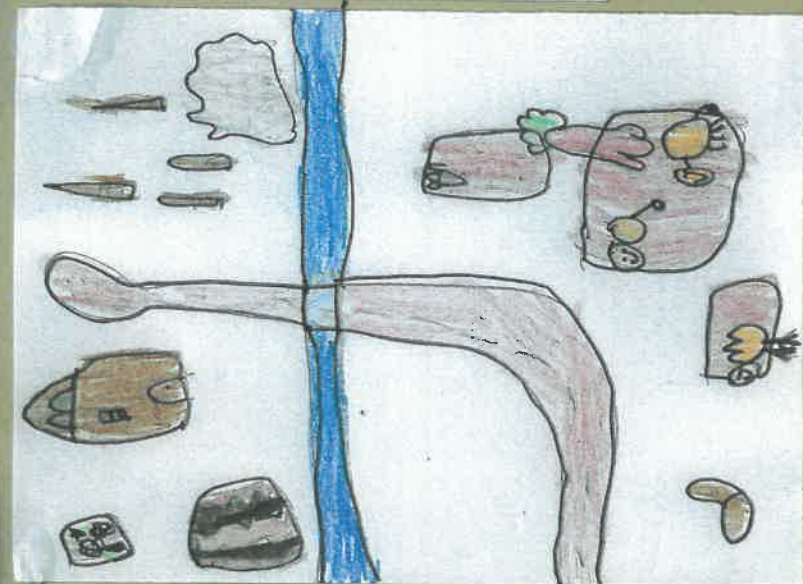


DEATH SAXONS!

How Did the ANGLO-SAXONS BUILD THEIR HOWSES? The ANGLO-SAXONS Made their houses out of mure, straw, mud, wood and woad. They pushed four hazel sticks in the ground around 2m apart and wove some willow in and out of the hazel to make it water proof and draught proof. Then they pated more daub on daub makes it warmer. If you wanted you can add some hair, reeds, and crushed chalk to the mixture.

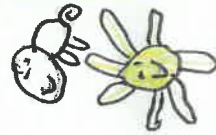

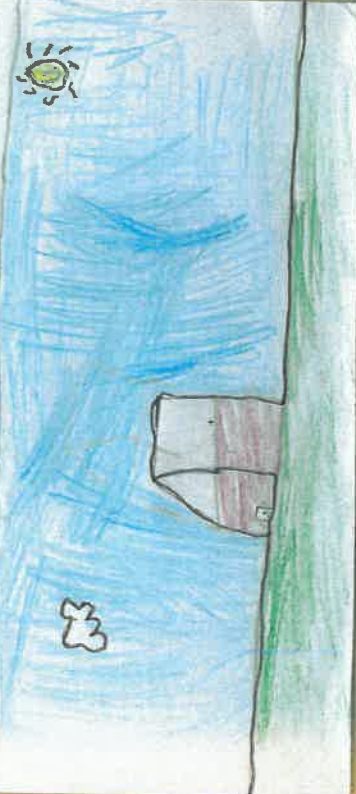
WHAT DID THE ANGLO-SAXON

OF LIME GREEN GRASS.

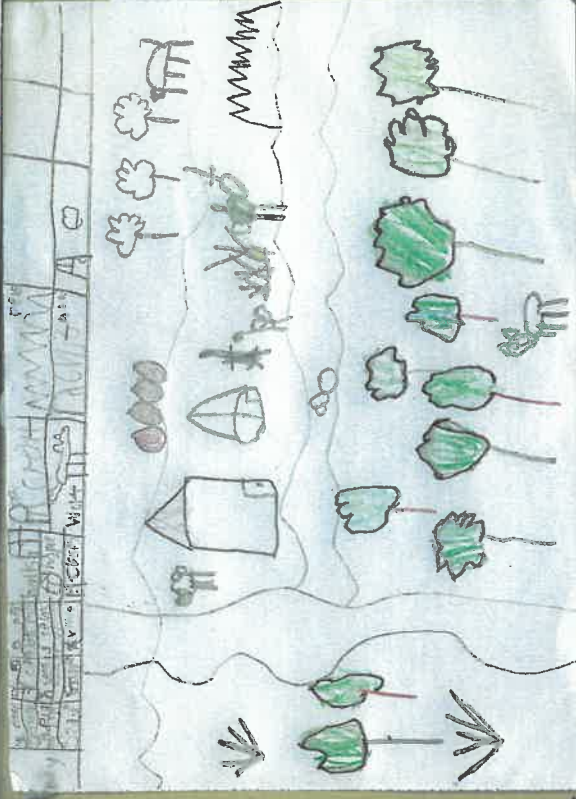


SHAWY ANGLO-SAXON

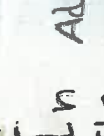
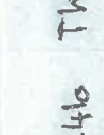
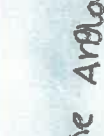
The Anglo-Saxons

In AD 410 The Anglo-Saxons took over the entire of Britain. They travelled up rivers in Kent to find somewhere to put there settlements.

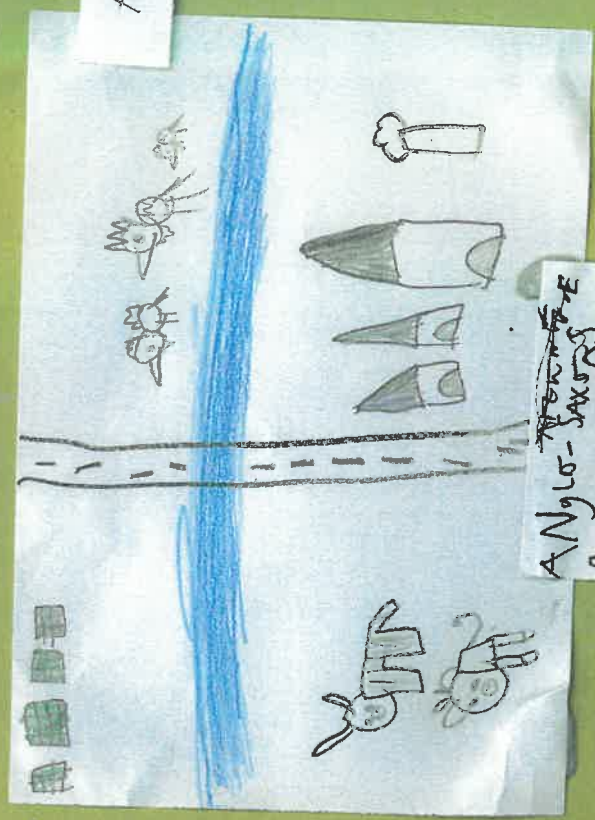

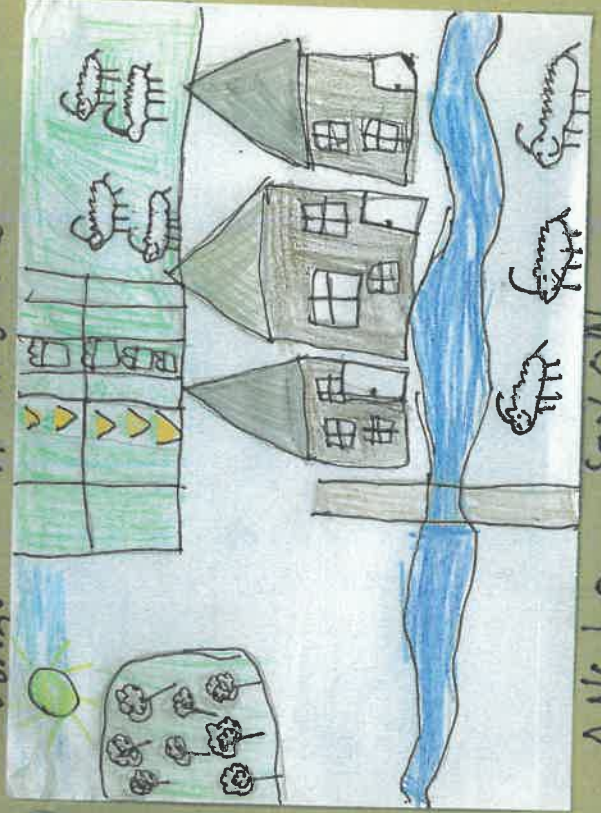
WHAT DID AN ANGLO-SAXON VILLAGE LOOK LIKE?
