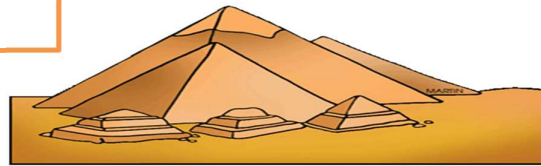

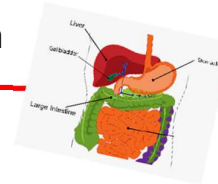
## Science

### Animals, including humans:

- describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.

### States of matter:
